POINTS FOR REFLECTION

- > "Greedy" brought with him an army of evils into the "Fishy World"

- ➤ A greedy person can never be happy
- > Greed a ever growing destroying cancer once enters into our heart.
- ➤ When "Greedy" had destgroyed all other fish from the ocean, **greed** destroyed Greedy:" through unhappiness and self-disgust.
- > The story of "Fishy World", unfortunately, has become history in our World!.
- > Greed is the root cause of all quarrels, fights and wars between persons and persons, families and families, nations and nations.
- ➤ If each one wants to have more and to be more than his neighbor. our world cannot survive
- ➤ Competition as a way of live is evil, baneful and fateful!
- Yet we encourage it in our homes, in our educational institutions, , in the social-political and economical life
- ➤ Love. justice, cooperation, and mutual understanding should the foundations of a peaceful and prosperous world.
