If a child lives with encouragement,
He learns confidence .(*Reflect*)

If a child lives with praise,
He learns to appreciate. (*Reflect*)

If a child lives with fairness,
He learns justice. (*Reflect*)

If a child lives with security,
He learns to have faith. (*Reflect*)

If a child lives with approval,
He learns to like himself. (*Reflect*)

If a child lives with love and
Friendship,
He learns to find love
in the world. (*Reflect*)

If a child lives with criticism,
He learns to condemn (*Reflect*)

If a child lives with hostility,
He learns to fight. (*Reflect*)

If a child lives with ridicule,
He learns to be shy. *(Reflect)*

If a child lives with shame,
He learns to feel guilty. *(Reflect)*

If a child lives with intolerance
He learns to reject others. *(Reflect)*

Points for Reflection

- Keeping in mind the atmosphere of your home, what does your child learn?
- Reflectively, go over the 11 points above – one by one - and see what sort of home life you have
- How are your children growing..
- Shared your reflections with your partner and – if possible - with your children and take the proper steps to make your home a learning lab of human growth for your kids.

Remember:

- Values are not taught but caught.
- Your children will learn what they see and experience, not what you tell them
- Keep in mind that:
 - Most likely, they will forget what you told them,
 - they may even forget what you did for them
 - But they will never forget how you made them feel. .
