Intent of the Story

- ✓ *To become aware of the injustices, very often done, in the name of democracy.*
- ✓ *Are democratic procedures really democratic or rather autocratic?*
- ✓ *Are elections, in all democracies free and with parity of opportunities to all parties?*

THE STORY

Many years ago far away from us, there was a densely populated country. It was economically rich, culturally learned and technologically advanced nation. The population of that country was equally divided into two halves. One of those halves about 50% of the people used to dress in white clothes while the other half, in black., the white dressed population

From times immemorial, at election times, when the polls were held, the "white-dressed half population controlling all the Government posts, the industry, the banking and finance, the press the radio and T.V., the schools and colleges, the judiciary, the army and the police - *with all that power in their hands,* - always won the elections. However, ostensibly, , calling themselves the "majority rule, they ruled the country most autocratically`

The "black-dressed" citizens resented the injustices done to them. Time and again, they demanded free and fair democratic elections with equal access for all to propaganda, and supervision at the polls. They organized themselves, they offered resistance, they protested, they went on strikes; they used even violence, but to no avail. The "white dressed" people having all the power in their hands, suppressed them, crushed them. Thus, time and again, by hook or by crook, they remained in power.

In the course of time, some "black-dressed" people discouraged and disgusted with the situation, lost interest in politic; others opted for silence, still others, being opportunists, become "turned coats" and joined the "white-dressed" ruling clan.
